The Organising Committee would like to thank you for your entry and wish you the very best of luck at the event. Daylight savings will be with us over the duration of our event – Yay! Please read through the following important information to help for smooth running of the competition:

REMINDERS:

Feed Supplier:

- **Feed orders** – our preferred stock feed is **Londonderry Stockfeeds**
 - Contact them on 02 4572 5592 OR txt your order to 0405 050 505
 - All feed orders should be placed with them by **Tuesday September 27th** for delivery to the venue on Friday 30th
 - If you order feed, please advise with details – kerrie.stapleton@bigpond.com

TEAM MANAGERS

- **A welcome pack** will be handed to the Club Team Manager on their arrival – these will include the following:
 - Competitor arm numbers
 - Competitor participation gift
 - Folder with information & allocations for the event
- **Bridle numbers** will be supplied for clubs, these will be available on your arrival to the venue –
 - **\$10 Bond per horse (please have this ready when you arrive)**
 - 2 bridle numbers per horse. One is for the competition bridle (to be worn on the outer side of the circle) and the other for a headstall.
 - Remember, the bridle number must be on the horse anytime it is out of the stable!
- **Squad Numbers** - teams are to supply their own squad competitor numbers.
- **Club Banners** should be handed in by 12.30pm on Sunday to the secretary's office ready for Arena set-up.
- **Horse Papers** should be handed in at the Secretary office prior to competition, as this is an FEI and EA event.
- **Perpetual Trophies** from 2019 should be handed to the Secretary's desk prior to start of competition.
- Return of arm & bridle numbers – Thursday after presentation
- Collection of horse papers - Thursday after presentation, along with club score sheets
- **Music** –
 - **All music to be submitted on a Club identified USB** to the secretary's office upon arrival. This will be kept in a container with the Music people in case needed.
 - Team Managers should organise a club member to check their music between 2pm -5pm on Sunday for Monday's program. Music for Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday can be checked after close of competition on the previous day.

ARENA USE & FAMILIARISATION

- The Horse Familiarisation Roster will be available shortly.

Practice Arenas:

- Arena 11: Available Sunday from 12pm for all competitors bumped into the event
- Arena 6: The practice arena outside the main arena will be available between sunrise & sunset from Monday
- Arena 4: The practice arena will be available between sunrise & sunset from Monday

TROT UP: (CVI horses only)

- A Trot Up roster will be made available, please have your papers ready.

CHEF d'EQUIPE'S MEETING:

- The meeting will be held on the concourse, near the canteen.
- The draw for the CVI classes will take place at this meeting.

STABLE AND CAMPSITE OPERATIONS: To ensure you receive your bond refund, please do not leave without checking in with the Managers.

- Please advise Kerrie Stapleton if you have a caravan arriving or feed being delivered!
- **This is an FEI event. The stables are a restricted area** and only for those that need to be there. The stable manager will monitor behaviour.
- There will be a Stable curfew (lights out) from 10.00pm – 6.30am each night.
- Clubs & horse owners are to supply their own water/feed buckets & cleaning equipment - rakes, bins & wheelbarrows. A manure stockpile is located close to the stables.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Please note that the only people allowed in the indoor arena will be those vaulters, horses and coaches who are next in line to compete, and this will be strictly enforced by the Marshalls.
- **DRAW CHANGES:** All changes once competition has started should go through your Team Manager to the Stewards for approval. Changes will then be sent through as required.
 - **ANY CHANGES otherwise will be eliminated**
- Allocations for Stables, Cabins & Camping will be available shortly
- **Social Dinner:** Under the continuing Covid climate we will not be organizing a social dinner.
 - Please be mindful of others when congregating across cohorts.
- **Vaulters Forum:** Monday 7pm at the indoor arena concourse area
- **Volunteers:** an event of any size cannot function without the wonderful help of volunteers.
 - Please help us in running a smooth competition by allocating your club helpers where needed.
 - New helpers are strongly encouraged to assist as training will be provided and it gives an insight into the running of the competition.
