### PROCEDURE FOR CHANGES TO THE FINAL DRAW:

Any alterations to the Draw must be received by Monday 6<sup>th</sup> October including the order of horses and the order of the vaulters on each horse. Every effort will be made to accommodate requests to ensure competitors have adequate time between competitions.

Changes to the Draw will be considered based on individual merit. Changes that involve changing the grade entered will be considered if the vaulter would have been able to enter that grade at the time of entry.

### ON THE DAY OF COMPETITION:

Any requests to change the Draw on the day of competition must be notified to the O/C via Secretary's desk. The O/C reserves the right to decline any changes. The President of the Ground Jury (PGJ) must confirm all changes.

If the change is accepted by the O/C and the PGJ then the Steward, Announcer, Marshall, Judges and Scorers will be notified via the official communication method.

**BUMP-IN: THURSDAY 9th OCTOBER** 

9:30am Bump-in (no earlier)

CVI Vet Inspection (Examination on Arrival)

CVI horses are required to wear bridle number on arrival for the Initial Vet Inspection.

9:30am - 10.30am Arena 5 access (Indoor) for riding or walking in hand (in bridle)

**PLEASE NOTE:** All horses are to wear Bridle numbers at all times whilst out of their stables

11:00am Secretary Office open

Collection of Club Arm numbers from secretary office

Bridle Numbers supplied by Owner

11:00 – 12:00pm Indoor Arena setup (club flags to Secretary Desk for setup)

12:00 – 2:00pm Music check

12:00pm CVI Horse Inspection (Trot-up) 12:45 pm (or Immediately after Horse Inspection)

Arena Familiarization for ALL CVI horses

Each horse will have 5 minutes in the arena to ride, lunge or vault.

2:00pm Chef's Meeting AND CVI1\* Draw - conference room

2:45pm Welcome & Opening Ceremony

2:45pm CVI Horse Development

6:30pm Chef's Meeting for 2\* & 3\* also 1\* transferring to Nationals

PLEASE NOTE: All horses are to wear Bridle numbers at all times whilst out of their stables

Return of any horse papers, banners will be after Sunday afternoon presentation, along with club score sheets

### ARENA FAMILIARISATION for National Horses on FRIDAY

### At Morning Tea

Horses to be hand walked only in groups, a timetable will be allocated.

#### **WARM-UP ARENAS**

Arenas 4 & 6 – will be available on Thursday from 10:00am – 6:00pm and from Friday between 6:30am & 6:00pm for all competitors.

### STABLE AND CAMPSITE OPERATIONS

- Stable Block A will be used for this event.
- FEI Stables are a Restricted Area. Authorized people only!
- Please remember to respect any venue signage, as we share the venue with Show Horse.
- Stable tools will be supplied by SIEC. Please remember to replace them at the end of each isle.
- If you require additional bales of bedding, please contact the stable manager and have correct cash ready for them.
- To ensure you receive your bond refund please do not leave without having your stable checked.
- There will be a Stable curfew (lights out) from 10:30pm 6:00am each night.
- The campsite curfew is from 10:30pm, when lights will be off. Please be respectful of others, always.
- Remember all electrical leads in the campsite need to have a current test and tag label.
- SIEC security and the Campsite Manager will inspect the camp area each night; please do not use spots you have not paid for. One lead permitted for each paid campsite.

### **PRESENTATIONS**

There will be a presentation each night after the last event. Please be ready in club uniform when requested. Sunday presentation will commence after the arena is packed up. Horses should present in bridles, vaulters in Club uniform.

### **CANTEEN**

The SIEC canteen within the indoor arena and Coffee Van will be open throughout the competition.

### **VOLUNTEERS SIGN-UP**

Our new **online SIGN-UP** system will be provided as a link so you can sign up for tasks that suit your availability. See the Secretary desk to check in for your duty, or to update the list.
