### CONDITIONS

#### Conditions of Entries for Nationals and Sydney CVI 2019

- The Australian Championships and the Sydney CVI are conducted as two events, and the Australian Champions will come from both events.
- **Starting possibilities:** it may be possible to enter both the CVI and the National class however this may only occur if the first class entered is completed prior to the start of the second class.
- Horse points must be strictly adhered to.

#### Conditions of Entries Australian Championships:

- **Clean Sport for Humans:** EA has been working closely with ASADA to introduce random drug testing at events throughout Australia. The link below contains current information regarding (human) athlete anti-doping in accordance with current ASADA/WADA rules. It is imperative that athletes, officials and coaches are familiar with the anti-doping policy and comply accordingly. <https://www.equestrian.org.au/content/clean-sport-humans>
- **AVR article 5.3:** To qualify for entry to Open Class competition a score of 6.5 in any one round in Advanced must have been obtained. Eligibility to remain in Open – a score of 6.5 in any one round of Open or Advanced must have been obtained in 2 years prior to the competition date. Vaulters will be required to submit the event at which the qualification was gained.
- **2 Squad reserves** may be entered via the Nominate Entry process. The final squad must be declared at the Chef d'Equipe meeting. The reserve vaulters must already be entered in the event. If not competing in another class, they must have paid to enter the Squad via Nominate to allow verification of membership of EA.
- Vaulting is an inclusive sport. The AWD perpetual prize is offered for vaulters with a disability. Integrated Pas de Deux and Squad classes must have at least one vaulter with a disability.
- All vaulters with a disability are encouraged to compete in the class they feel most comfortable.
- Athletes with a disability need to indicate on the Nominate entry form to be considered for the AWD perpetual award.
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to split classes that are oversubscribed. The draw for each split class will be determined through a random allocation of vaulters entered.
- **Pas de Deux A Classes** are for combinations previously scoring 6.0 or higher
- **Pas de Deux B Classes** are for combinations previously scoring up to 6.0.
- **New Pas de Deux combinations** should start in the level best suited to their ability.

### Lunger & Horse Development Classes:

- **Lungers Classes:** (either at Canter or Walk)
  - Lungers must nominate the horse to be lunged.
  - Horse points for Canter Class will be 1 point.
  - Horse points for Walk Class will be 0.5 point.
  - Judging will be based on the horse score component of FEI/AVR rules.
  - Lunger must enter, salute, put the horse on a circle, trot a circle then walk or canter (depending on class entered) the horse for one minute, halt, salute and then exit. Lungers may have a person run in to assist with the whip.
  - Administration Levy will apply to Lungers in this class.
  
- **Horse Development Class:** (guidelines as per EA website)
  - One (1) Horse point will be allocated for this class each day.
  - Open to all horses, however no places are awarded.
  - Max of 3 minutes per horse, with or without vaulters.
  - The horse is required to show a minimum of 2 gaits with or without a vaulter.
  - Judged with scores and comments, but no placings.

#### Equestrian Australia Vaulting Committee Perpetual Awards:

For the purpose of the Perpetual Awards both National and CVI classes will be recognized.

Perpetual Awards are for EA members only.

Official classes are Open, CVI3\*, Advanced, CVI2\*, Intermediate, CVI1\* and Novice

- National Champion Female Individual - Perpetual Trophy and Sash for the winning combination (Vaulteer, Horse, Lunger) awarded to the winner of the Highest Official Individual Class – Female
- National Champion Male Individual - Perpetual Trophy and Sash for the winning combination (Vaulteer, Horse, Lunger) awarded to the winner of the Highest Official Individual Class – Male
- National Champion Athlete with a Disability - Perpetual Trophy and Sash for the winning combination (Vaulteer, Horse, Lunger) awarded to the winner of the Highest AWD Individual Class
- National Champion Pas de Deux - Perpetual Trophy and Sash for the winning combination (PDD, Horse, Lunger) awarded to the winner of the Highest Official Pas De Deux Class
- National Champion Squad - Perpetual Trophy and Sash for the winning combination (Squad, Horse, Lunger) awarded to the winner of the Highest Official Squad Class
- National Champion Horse - Horse High Score Award – awarded to horse with the highest average horse score from any Final Score (averaged from each test) from any Individual/PDD/Squad (Intermediate and above). To be presented with a Sash.

#### Squad:

- Medallions for first, second and third placings (including lunger)
- Ribbons for fourth to sixth placings (including lunger)

#### Barrel classes:

- Ribbons for first to sixth place.

A small token will be provided to each vaulter as recognition of their participation.

### Presentation of Awards

- Presentation of ribbons will take place at the end of each day's competition.
- Presentation of Perpetual Awards will take place at the Presentation Dinner at the completion of the event.
- Club tracksuits or suitable attire is required for all presentations.
- CVI Horses are required to attend all CVI presentations and National horses are welcome to attend the final day presentation.

### Veterinary Notes for Australian Vaulting Championships & Sydney CVI3\*

At this event, FEI rules will be followed and applied to all horses competing in CVI events.

#### 1<sup>st</sup> Horse Inspection:

**Arrival inspection:** 12pm – 5pm on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2019. If your arrival falls outside these times, please contact Gillian Burns 0408 187 639 to organise a mutually suitable time.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> Horse Inspection – ‘Trot up’:

**Horse Inspection:** Scheduled for 8am Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2019. Horses should be presented in a bridle with reins, the bridle number attached to the outside.

During the course of the event, all CVI horses are under the FEI Veterinary Regulations. This means that they cannot be attended to by a veterinarian unless they are a PTV organised by the OC, or unless the attending veterinarian is a PTV and has made his or her presence known to the Veterinary Delegate. This includes overnight emergencies.

#### FEI Equine Anti-Doping and Controlled Medication Regulations:

CVI horses may be subjected to random testing by the FEI throughout the entire CVI event. National horses will be subjected to testing by EA.

#### Security:

All CVI horses must remain on the grounds of the venue for the duration of the event. Stable security is of paramount importance and there must be compliance with access restrictions imposed by the Organising Committee. Only Competitors, Lungers and Grooms are permitted in the Stable areas and walkways.

Please keep in mind that the veterinarians are there to help you get your horse into competition. It is their job to assist you in supporting your horse throughout the weekend.

### Bio-Security:

**This event is being conducted within an area where Hendra is present.**

### DPI – White Park Horse Events: Biosecurity guidelines for organisers and competitors

All event participants have a responsibility to maintain good biosecurity, and not put the health of other people's horses at risk.

Horses at events have the potential to spread infectious disease. Horse events act as multipliers for the spread of infectious diseases should an outbreak occur.

Horses that are suspected of suffering from infectious or contagious diseases or have been in contact with other animals suffering from such diseases **MUST NOT** be brought to horse events.

It is each owner's responsibility to ensure that they manage their own biosecurity risks. Visitors to the event should not touch any horses but their own. Clubs must limit the vaulters who have access to the stable to a minimum.

A Horse Health Declaration must be filled out for each horse and presented upon arrival at the venue. This declaration will be made available through Nominat. Hendra vaccinated horses must present a current Hendra Vaccination Certificate.

Also remember that if your horse is not vaccinated against Hendra and becomes ill with any signs that suggest Hendra, the treatments available to that horse may be limited until Hendra has been ruled out.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

#### EA Membership

- Lungers & Vaulters are required to hold current EA membership.
- Refer [EA National Membership Structure](#)

#### Competitor Numbers

- **Show Office:** Open from 12pm Friday Sept 28th
- **Vaulter Numbers:** A refundable deposit of \$20 per vaulter is required, either by cash or chq.
- **Bridle Numbers:** 2 sets to be provided by horse owner
  - All horses MUST wear bridle number whilst outside stables (both sides of halter & bridle)
  - Bridle Number allocation will be supplied by the o/c
- **Squad Numbers:** Teams are to supply their own squad competitor numbers.

#### Refund Policy

- Class refunds will only be considered after the close of entries accompanied by Doctor's and/or Veterinarian's Certificate, at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
- The Administration Levy will be retained by the Organising Committee.
- **Stables & Camping Refunds:**
  - Refunds will be considered by the Organising Committee, after one week prior to event.
  - Venue requirements MUST be considered upon any request for refunds.

### Camping & Stabling

#### Camping:

- **NOTE -There is NO powered campsites at present.**
- NON Powered Camping: \$20 per vehicle per day.
- Tent camping is available and will be allocated with Club groups where possible.
- Each vehicle to display camping receipt, which can be printed off after payment to Nominate.

#### Stables:

- 156 x Timber Stables – size 3.5m x 3.5m
- 12 x Stallion Stables - size 3.65m x 3.65m (these will be reserved for CVI Horses)
- **Stables** are available at \$25.00 per night and will be supplied with bedding.
- First Night will be at \$41 which includes 1 bag of bedding to be used to top up your stable.
- Additional bales are available at \$16.00 per bale.
- A stabling Bond of \$105 will include: \$75 Stable Cleaning Bond & \$30 Hot weather Bond. Stable Bonds will be refunded by Nominate if applicable, post event.
- Calculating stable costs: Per stable – 1 day: \$146.00; 2 days: \$171.00; 3 days: \$196.00; 4 days: \$221.00; 5 days: \$246.00; 6 days: \$271.00;
- **Bump out: Stables are required to be cleaned of ALL bedding on Bump out** (to be checked by Stable manager for refund eligibility)
- Tack Rooms: \$20 per day (stables will be used) – please supply your own padlock if desired
- All bookings for stabling and camping must be completed by **Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September** on Nominate to allow adequate time for preparation.
- **Clubs & horse owners are to supply their own water/feed buckets & cleaning equipment - rakes, bins & wheelbarrows.** A manure stockpile is located close to the stables.

#### NOMINATE - 2 Entry Processes

- **Club Entry:**

This system is to register a new club, squad, horse and lunger details with Nominate and must be submitted prior to Nominate opening for Vaulter entries.

**Please supply any new details by Tuesday 6th August.**

- Adjustments & additions to horses & lunger information
- Adjustments & additions to squad and club names
- If you **are not** entering as a competitor and wish to receive competition information via email please register here (team managers, lungers, volunteers not already entered)
- No money transfer will be necessary
- Please allow 48 hours for horse details to be added to the database for vaulters to select when placing their entries.

- **Events Program** – Club profile should be completed via the Club Entry on Nominate. Maximum 300 words to be submitted along with relevant photo. Example: Horse and Club Photo.

- **Vaulter Entry:**

This is the usual entry for vaulters to enter classes and select horse and lunger combinations via Nominate.

### HOW TO USE NOMINATE ENTRY SYSTEM

*Entries via Nominate Website [www.nominate.com.au](http://www.nominate.com.au) For assistance Ph: (07) 3118 9555*

Competitors are responsible for entering the correct classes. Prior to starting the entry process identify the classes to enter and confirm with your club as to what horse and lunger you will be using. This information needs to be correct for the draw.

Once you have selected the correct event, scroll to the bottom of the page for the competition.

Click the button "Click Here to Enter":

- Nominate will prompt you to fill in any required fields. Once completed the first page "Competition Entry Form" you will click next to go to stage 2.
- Competition Entry Stage 2 will require you to select the first class to enter then select the horse/lunger combination from the dropdown list.
- To add enter more classes click "Add Horse / Class" button. Once entered all classes click "Next" and this will take you to confirmation page and payments. If you have entered a squad or pas de deux you will be asked additional questions.

#### *Correcting Errors After Payment has been made to Nominate*

Refunds are available until the closing date for incorrect classes entered. If you have entered and paid for a class incorrectly, i.e. selected the wrong class or selected the wrong horse/lunger combination and have finalised the payment, then you will need to contact Nominate and request a refund for the incorrect entry. You will then need to enter the class correctly. To avoid paying the Admin Levy a second time you will need to enter the "Previous Invoice Number" on the Competition Entry Form. Your Previous Invoice Number will be found on your copy of the receipt that you will have been emailed. Continue with placing the correct entry ensuring class number and horse and lunger details are correct.

#### *Correcting Errors After Closing Date*

After the closing date, if you need to make a correction you will need to obtain a password from Nominate to avoid paying the late fee. Enter the password and tick the box for the discount and the late fee will not be charged. Any new entries during the late period will incur the late fee.

Any changes after final close of the event will need to be made manually on the draw and may incur a \$10 fee to be paid prior to arm numbers being provided.

- 1 x Dropbox folder per club or group

1. The Team Manager or a nominated person from each club/competitor is to share their music Dropbox\*. This person will be the contact person for music and will be contacted if there are any problems or questions.
2. Each file must be clearly **labelled as follows**:
  - a. Individual competitors: "Club, Surname, First initial, Grade, Compulsories or Freestyle"
  - b. Pas de Deux: " Club, both Surnames, Horse, Grade"
  - c. Squad: "Club, Squad name, Grade, Compulsories or Freestyle"
  - d. Where the club uses compulsory music for everyone using a particular horse: "Club Name, Horse's Name, Class"
  - e. Run in music: "Club name, Run in"
  - f. Individuals with their own run in: "Last name, classes in which this will be used"  
example: Smith, Run in Ind &/or Pdd)

\*When there are siblings competing please **always** include first initial to avoid confusion

\*\* **A single folder** containing all the correctly labelled music (i.e. no sub folders)

3. CD's, emails or USB sticks are not correct forms of delivery and will **NOT** be accepted. Alternative arrangements will only be made in exceptional circumstances.
4. **MP3 format is REQUIRED** and is the only format that will be accepted. Volume control on other file formats may be limited and can affect the music during the competition. The club's team manager will be notified if a file format is not acceptable. The music compiler **will not** amend incorrectly formatted files.
5. A **final check** to ensure all the music has been received cannot be done until the final draw has been distributed. Clubs / individuals are responsible for keeping their own list of the music they need and what has been sent through.
6. **It is essential that all clubs / individuals bring a copy of all music in MP3 format on a flash drive to the event in case a file has been mislaid or corrupted during the sending process.**
