2013 ENSW Award Nominations

ENSW is calling for nominations for the Equestrian NSW Annual Awards for 2013. Please send all nominations to **VNSW** secretary by 10th December, as awards are due to EA in December.

The 2014 award categories for each discipline will be as follows; the winners in the following six categories must be decided upon by the discipline committee/council.

- Young Athlete of the Year In line with competition age groups for most disciplines and the National awards this is a rider/athlete under the age of 21 (Vaulting under the age of 18)
- Senior Athlete of the Year Senior rider/athlete 21 years and over (Vaulting 18 yrs & over)
- Horse of the Year Ideally will be a horse domiciled and registered with ENSW and one which has
 competed in domestic competitions of course international results should also be recognised
 assuming the horse fulfils the other criteria..

- Owner of the Year This would be a member of ENSW/EA. Your owner of the year need not
 automatically be the owner of your horse of the year recipient, you may wish to consider winners
 who may not have the best performed horse but who have made a significant contribution to the
 sport by owning a horse/s who have helped achieve results, catapult a rider to new success or
 improve your sport over the past twelve months.
- Gow Gates Services to the Sport see attached nomination form
- One "Wild Card" Award discipline specific

Volunteer of the Year – see attached document

In order to align ourselves with the National Awards the following categories will be introduced for 2013. Each discipline may nominate more than one recipient.

The ENSW Board will decide on the overall winner in each of the following four categories. Nomination forms are attached.

- Official of the Year –This award is to recognise the dedication and performance of officials who
 display a high level of excellence and to reward their continuing contribution to the sport.
- Event of the Year This award is to recognise events run by affiliated clubs or show societies that
 have achieved a standard of excellence greater than that of other sporting events during the same
 period.
- **Club of the Year** This award is to recognise affiliated clubs that have achieved a high standard of performance in governance, member development and event management.
- **Administrator of the Year** This award recognises the outstanding achievements made by volunteer administrators who give their time and services to clubs or events.

Award Guidelines:

- 1. The award nominee must be an ENSW member
- 2. More than one nomination may be submitted (each nomination must be completed separately)
- 3. The period covering the nomination is from January 2013 to December 2013
- 4. Nomination forms including high resolution photo and CV must be submitted

- 3. Have a current First Aid Certificate
- 4. Current EA Membership
- 5. Completed ASC Beginning Coaching Workbook OR Online Course
- 6. Obtain Current Public Liability & Errors & Omissions Insurance for Coaching activities.
