CONDITIONS OF ENTRIES

- Competition Eligibility – Vaulters are eligible to compete in:
 - a) Individual (one horse and one barrel class)
 - b) Squad (one horse and one barrel squad class). If entering the participation classes a vaulter may enter one squad compulsory class and one squad freestyle class.
 - c) Pas de Deux (one horse and one barrel class)
- All competitors to ensure they are entered in the correct individual grade as per the current Australian Vaulting Rules.
- Athletes with a disability will need to indicate where appropriate on the Nominate entry form to be considered for the AWD prizes, which will be awarded within each grade.
- Class refunds will only be considered after the close of entries accompanied by Doctor's and/or Veterinarian's Certificate. The administration levy will be retained by the organising committee.
- Membership of Equestrian Australia as per the [EA Membership Structure](#). Those in participant classes may be a member of SVG. Membership forms are available from Julia Dickens email sydneyvaultinggroup@gmail.com
- All horses competing in official events must be EA registered. Details of all horse/lunger combinations to be forwarded to enable pre-entry to Nominate.
- Clubs are to supply their own team numbers.

MUSIC

- Music for running in/out, compulsories and freestyle is to be submitted in mp3 format no later than Friday 4th March 2022.
- Music to be submitted via www.dropbox.com.
- Each club to make their own folder and share it with the email address: nswvaultingmusic@gmail.com



CONDITIONS FOR CLASSES

- Classes 1: Open Individual will be one round with all three tests.
- Classes 2: Advanced Individual will be run over two rounds. Second round will be freestyle only.
- Class 7 & 8 Preliminary Introductory - for vaulters who wish to enter Preliminary in separate compulsory & freestyle classes.
- Horse Development – only one vaulter need enter the horse. Additional vaulters may vault if required, Maximum time in arena per horse is 3 mins. No prizes will be awarded.
- Classes 17 & 22 Pas de Deux (A) combinations previously scoring 6.0 or higher.
- Classes 18 & 23 Pas de Deux (B) combinations previously scoring up to 6.0. New Pas de Deux combinations are encouraged to start in the level best suited to their ability.
- Class 24: Barrel Team – Six Vaulters. Max Time: 4mins
- The Organising Committee reserves the right to change or amend the schedule and split classes.
- The following classes are considered “Closed Events” and as such only members of SVG or EA members can enter. Classes 5, 6, 7, 8, 12, 13, 17, 18,19-25. All other classes are Official Events for EA members.
- Horse points as per the current Australian Vaulting Rules. Point allocations for additional classes are as follows:
 - Classes 7 & 8 = 0.5pts each round
 - Class 9 = 2pts
- Placings: Ribbons to 6th for all events (except development horse class).

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Vaulters and officials must observe the EA Code of Conduct.
- Competition etiquette should be observed at all times.
- Officials, coaches, lungers and spectators to set their mobile phones to silent mode.
- All children must be under the supervision of an adult.
- All clubs are responsible for ensuring that the property of Evans Park and other parties is respected and are liable for any damage caused.
- Competitors must comply with any instruction given by officials and/or organisers of the event.
- Unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated from competitors or spectators.



GENERAL INFORMATION

- Start time: 8.30am Saturday & Sunday (pending number of entries)
- Ground Jury and Protests: As per Equestrian Australia National Vaulting Rules
- Show secretary will be available from 7.30am Saturday to advise of any scratchings.
- Any changes to the draw need to be advised by 5pm Wednesday 16th March 2022.
- Team Managers meetings will only be initiated if required anytime throughout the event.
- Presentations will take place on the Saturday and Sunday at the completion of the classes.
- Bump In is from 2pm Friday.
- Camping: \$45 powered site per vehicle/site per night. Limited Power available. \$35 per night, non powered site. Each vehicle to display camping receipt, which can be printed off after payment to Nominate.
- Permanent yards at Evans Park: \$50 per horse per night. Availability of sufficient yards at Evans Park cannot be guaranteed.
- BYO portable yards \$35 per night. As per the EA General Regulations 109.3 ***Stable, yards and portable yards (if used) must be a minimum of 3 metres x 3 metres and be of safe and solid construction.***
- All yards have a \$30 cleaning bond.
- Alternative off-site stabling &/or yards can be arranged.
- Accommodation in bunk rooms \$90 per night.

Biosecurity & Covid guidelines will be sent out in the vaulters notes closer to the event.
