#### **LAST MINUTE REMINDERS:**

#### **VENUE EXIT & ENTRY:**

Main entry for officials & horses is Guernsey Street entrance. Please be conscious this is a road, with pedestrian access to stables.

As this is an FEI event, please ensure both entrance gates are closed at all times.

As this facility is quite open plan, please be mindful of others throughout this event, and be aware of signage around the venue.

#### **CAMPING:**

Campers should access the Hill Street entrance at all times. Access to stable area by car will be restricted.

No fires or pits, are allowed at the venue.

#### **HORSE EXAMINATION ON ARRIVAL:**

As per Article 1032, all horses will be inspected upon arrival prior to entering the stables. This examination is to identify the horse and conduct a brief physical examination. This is not a lameness or fitness test.

**Please present your Horse Health Declaration to Gillian on arrival.**

If you have any biosecurity concerns about your horse at that time, please let Gillian Burns know. In order to complete this inspection, Gillian will need to meet you at White Park upon your arrival. Please text her with your arrival time. Her number is: 0408-187-639. Your horse should not move into its box or be close to other competitors until after it has been examined.

**For Bio security reasons do not touch any horses unless authorised.**

#### **VOLUNTEERS:**

As a National competition there is a significant number of helpers are required. We have allocated the rostered positions by club with the aim of ensuring each club only receive a couple of duties each day.

We also recognise and greatly appreciate the significant additional roles, in addition to club duties, conducted by Southern Highlands, Equiste and Scone.
